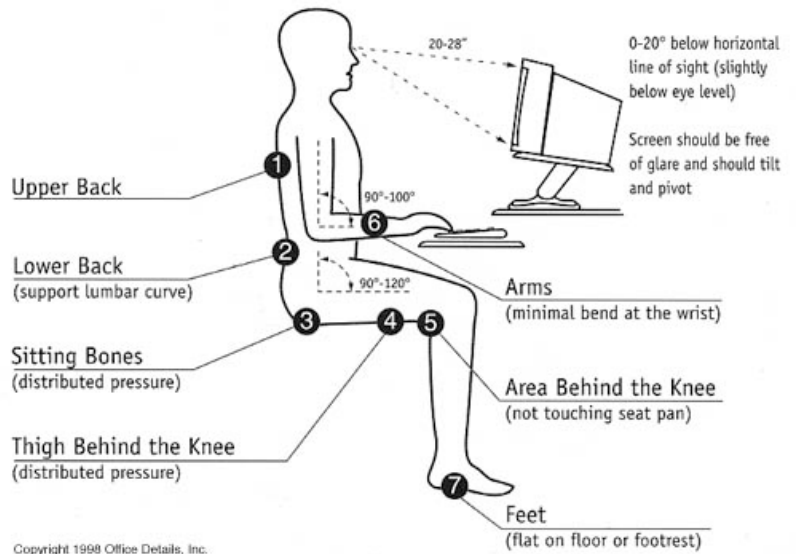

SAFE WALKING RULES

1. Cross streets at CORNERS only.
2. Never walk into the street from between parked cars.
3. Obey traffic signs and signals — cross on GREEN or "WALK" only.
4. Wait on sidewalk — not in street — for GREEN light or for gap in traffic if corner has no traffic signal.
5. Cross street in crosswalks—don't cross intersections diagonally.
6. Look LEFT for few steps and then RIGHT for traffic while crossing. Walk slowly for hearing cars.
7. After getting off bus or street car, don't go around it, front or rear. Wait until it leaves before crossing.
8. Don't play in or run into the street.
9. At night in poorly lighted streets carry something white. Don't rely on drivers seeing you.
10. Walk on LEFT facing traffic where no sidewalk is provided.
